Last spring, we awarded the l@ch@mbrebl@nche prize to Noémi Otis. As part of this prize, the artist takes advantage of a production residency in our laboratories from February 4 to March 21, 2020. We

In her practice, Otis creates hermetic, protected, anxiogenic and vulnerable universes. She wonders about the notions of artificiality, aesthetics and distance between the real and the fake.

For her residency at LA CHAMBRE BLANCHE, Noémi Otis wishes to experiment with various technologies in order to deepen her relationship with the object. Indeed, she wants to make a box that will create an indirect relationship between a physical object and the spectator. The box and the digital interface will create a distance from the object, but at the same time the possibility of an exchange.

This residency will be an excuse for the artist to acquire new technical knowledge and apply it in the creation of her digital device.

A native of Baie-Comeau, Noémi Otis lives and works in Quebec City. In 2016, she obtains a college diploma in Fashion Design at the École de mode of Notre-Dame-de-Foy Campus. In 2019, she received a bachelor's degree in visual and media arts at the Université Laval École d'art. In her practice, Noémi Otis explores the various forms that artifice and human beings take.
