LA CHAMBRE BLANCHE invites the public to meet Alexandre David during an *in situ* residency from March the 16th to April the 22th. *Tourner le coin* is an architectural installation that will seem to take form as we walk through the gallery space.

When walking on the sidewalk or inside a building, every movement we make is adjusted to a construction that has precisely been thought out for these movements. This simple correspondence between our experience of architecture and the architecture itself has inspired this project. The artist will build an architectural structure, made out of wood and plywood, that will progressively take form in the gallery space. This installation will expand daily and adjust itself to the comings and goings of visitors. Although there can't be any real simultaneousness between a built environment and its use, this project aims to create a sensation of equivalence between the way one can move around in the space and the way the installation shifts from one area to another.

*Alexandre David lives in Montreal, but works in Quebec City as a part-time lecturer at « l'École des arts visuels de l'Université Laval ». His work has been shown in Canada, the United Kingdom and the Netherlands, in group shows and solos shows, including one at the « Musée d'art contemporain de Montréal » in 2002. In 2006 he was awarded the Louis-Comtois prize.*
